Lab Technician:

Employee needed for lab duties including but not limited to cleaning and prepping equipment, labeling sample analysis bags and plates, recording data, cataloging and updating inventory logs, and conducting basic experiments. Must be familiar or willing to become proficient in Microsoft Excel (using equations, functions, ect.) and Microsoft Word for data collection and recording. This position offers flexible hours and opportunity for advancement.

Seed Warehouse Employee:
