Jim Wilson moved to make the following changes to the Livestock CDE:

- Change questions from 10 points to five points each and keep 5 questions for each species
- Add another set of oral reasons for a total of three sets, each on a different species
- Drop cattle grading
- Add meat goats as a possible class

Second by Evan Papousek, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to change the point values for deductions on meat grading so they follow the national rules and work with JudgingCard.com. Second by Mike Brink, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to update the Food Science CDE so the food product category matches national rules. Second by Etta Knuth, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to switch the Ag Communications CDE back to the Fall Leadership CDEs. South Dakota will have a different theme than nationals – the state office will determine the theme by September 15<sup>th</sup>. Second by Etta Knuth, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to change the point values for Vet Science to the following: 50 points for equipment ID, 30 points for parasite ID, and 50 points for breed ID. Each ID is worth two points. Second by Ed Mueller, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to fix the wording in the Horse Judging rules to clarify the halter and performance classes. Second by Christi Ryen, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to change the questions in Horse Judging to five points each (from 10 points). Secondy Christi Ryen, motion passed.

Jim Wilson moved to accept the Land Judging CDE rules as presented. Second by Kelly O'Donnell, motion passed.
